About Itaú-Unibanco

Banco Itaú took over Unibanco at November 3, 2008 to form Itaú Unibanco Holding S.A. The full integration of all operations and business shall be completed in two or three years. Itaú Unibanco will be the largest financial conglomerate in the Southern Hemisphere and one of the 20 largest in the world. Because the merge between the two banks is so recent, some of the policies have not been updated yet and it is not always clear whether the bank as a whole has signed certain policies. The bank has its headquarters in São Paulo, Brazil, and its activities/products include: asset management, investment banking, insurance, private equity, and retail banking.
