

## Credit Suisse position on anti-personnel mines and cluster munitions

Given the background of the International Convention on Anti-Personnel Mines and the International Convention on Cluster Munitions, which prevent the state parties from, among other things, using, producing and transferring anti-personnel mines and cluster munitions or assisting anyone to engage in such activities, Credit Suisse will not enter into business relationships with producers of these weapons and is terminating any existing business activities with such companies.

Furthermore, Credit Suisse will cease to hold securities of anti-personnel mines or cluster munitions producers in its proprietary trading book or to include them in its actively-managed retail and institutional funds and in discretionary mandates. In addition, Credit Suisse will refrain from issuing research recommendations on such companies.

We will continue to closely follow national and international legal developments to ensure that our business activities remain in full compliance with all applicable laws and regulations in the jurisdictions in which we do business.
