## What do they do?

Elbit Systems Ltd. is Israel's largest arms manufacturer and one of the world's largest defense electronics manufacturers.<sup>2</sup>

#### Military equipment: Producing the killer drones

As one of the primary suppliers of Israel's military, navy, and airforce technology and equipment, Elbit has profited greatly from Israel's many attacks on Palestinian and Lebanese people.

Elbit designs and supplies integrated UAS (Unmanned Aircraft Systems) for a range of applications. It is also applying the UAS technology to unmanned ground vehicles and marine vessel activities.<sup>3</sup>

Elbit produces the Hermes 450 drone,<sup>4</sup> aptly described as the "workhorse of the IDF."<sup>5</sup>

Drones from the larger Hermes models can reportedly be outfitted with two

missiles, and in addition to their use for scouting and tracking targets, they were used in some of the more horrific incidents in the 2006 war on Lebanon and the 2008-2009 war on Gaza.<sup>6</sup> In the 23-day assault on Gaza, missiles

fired from drones were directly attributed to the killing of 78 Palestinians, including 29 children, and wounding 73 others.<sup>7</sup> The Hermes has sensors so precise that they enable a drone operator to read a license plate number and determine whether a person on the ground is armed. Infrared sensors provide imaging by day and night.<sup>8</sup> This makes the killing of civilians all the more troubling.

The use of Israeli drones for targeted killings with Elbit's Hermes drones has been condemned by Human Rights

"Every night the Palestinians in Gaza relive their worst nightmares when they hear drones; it never stops and you are never sure if it is a surveillance drone or if it will launch a rocket attack. Even the sound of Gaza is frightful, the sound of the Israeli drones in the sky."

Watch<sup>9</sup> and has prompted Amnesty International to call for a suspension of UK arms sales to Israel.<sup>10</sup> The continuous use of Israeli drones over Gaza's airspace has been described in the Goldstone Report as one of the elements of the Gaza blockade, conforming the report's legal opinion that Israel remains the occupying power over Gaza.<sup>11</sup>

Israeli drones were also used in the disastrous flotilla attack.<sup>12</sup> Elbit has successfully tested a new generation of drones that can go as far as Iran.<sup>13</sup>

Elbit sells its drones to a good number of countries<sup>14</sup> including the US, where they have been used for surveillance by the Border Patrol in the Arizona/Mexico border.<sup>15</sup>

Additionally, other countries, including the United States, <sup>16</sup> use drones for surveillance and targeted killings, with equally horrific results as Israel--and we condemn the use of drones there as well.

The Brookings Institute estimates that in Pakistan, for every militant killed, 10 or so civilians also died.<sup>17</sup> The the New America Foundation, found that since 2004, some 32% of those killed in Pakistan by drone strikes were civilians.<sup>18</sup> We join the United Nations special rapporteur on extrajudicial, summary or arbitrary executions in condemning drone attacks wherever they occur. But we clearly state that the fact that other countries use drones is no reason to exempt Israel from scrutiny.

#### Building Walls in Palestine and on the US/ Mexico Border

Elbit and its subsidiaries manufacture some of the surveillance equipment on the Apartheid Wall (Lorros surveillance cameras, unmanned ground vehicles, and the TORCH surveillance system).<sup>19</sup> The The construction of the wall in the West Bank, including in and around East Jerusalem, has been declared illegal by the international Court of Justice.<sup>20</sup>

European pension fund are divesting from Elbit, what about TIAA-CREF retirement money?

Having tested its technology on the Apartheid Wall, Elbit is now exporting it to the United States through its American subsidiary, Kollsman, Inc.<sup>21</sup>

Much as the Apartheid Wall separates Palestinians and grabs Palestinian land, the US-Mexico wall has also been accused of dividing indigenous populations<sup>22</sup> and arbitrarily grab the land of the poor in the United States.<sup>23</sup> Norway's Pension Fund divested from Elbit.<sup>24</sup> The fund is Europe's largest investment fund and held nearly 6 million dollars worth of shares in Elbit.<sup>25</sup>

He was was arrested by Israeli soldiers as he was legally crossing the border from Jordan to Palestine. He was coming back from a trip to Norway where he met with senior officials,

including Norwegian Finance Minister Kristen Halvorsen.<sup>26</sup> Mohammad was imprisoned on September 22, 2009, and was only released in January, after Amnesty International had declared him a prisoner of conscience.<sup>27</sup>

Less than a year later, the Swedish national pension fund divested from Elbit as well.<sup>28</sup> Additional financial institutions have divested as well: Kommunal Landspensjonkasse (one of the largest life insurance companies in Norway), Danske Bank (the largest bank in Denmark), PKA Ltd. (one of the largest Danish pension funds)<sup>29</sup>
